# How to Use This Resource

These Scripture cards are designed to be simple companions for your time with God. They are not meant to become another routine to perfect, but gentle reminders you can return to whenever you need encouragement, grounding, or reflection.

You may use them in whatever way best supports your current season. Below are a few suggested approaches.

First of all, print and cut out all 16 scripture cards.

## **Daily Reflection**

- You may choose one card each day.
- Read the Scripture slowly.
- Reflect on the scripture.
- Sit with it and allow it to guide your prayer or journaling.

You do not need to rush through the cards. Some truths are meant to be revisited more than once.

## **Quiet Time Companion**

- You can use these cards alongside your Bible reading or devotional time.
- Place one inside your Bible or journal
- Write down any thoughts, emotions, or insights that surface

Allow the Scripture to shape both your understanding and your conversation with God.

## **Gentle Reminders Throughout the Day**

You may also use these cards as visual reminders of truth.

Some people choose to:

- Place them near a prayer space
- Keep one at their desk or bedside
- Save them as phone wallpapers
- Carry one in a wallet or journal
